### Die Walkuere

Act I—Taking refuge in Hunding's hut from a storm, Siegmund discovers Hunding's wife Sieglinde. Upon his return Hunding observes the likeness between the two and learns that Siegmund is the son of his mortal enemy. Sieglinde, now in love with Siegmund, pours a sleeping potion into Hunding's goblet, and then tells Siegmund the story of her abduction and forced marriage. She shows him the sword buried in an ash tree by a one-eyed warrior—destined for the man strong enough to remove it. Comparing stories they discover they are brother and sister as well as lovers, and that the magical sword is for their protection. Siegmund takes it and the two now fearful of Hunding's wrath, escape.

Act II—Although Wotan instructs Brunnhilde that Hunding is to die, his wife Fricka, guardian of the marriage vow, insists that the adulterers Siegmund and Sieglinde must be punished, and extracts his promise not to safeguard his son. Brunnhilde, now commanded by Wotan to protect Hunding, and lead Siegmund to Valhalla, vainly pleads his case as he arrives with the exhausted Sieglinde. Moved by the couple's devotion, Brunnhilde promises Siegmund victory despite Wotan's decree, but as he rushes to meet the approaching Hunding his sword is shattered by Wotan. Defenseless, Siegmund is felled by Hunding who in turn is killed by a scornful wave of Wotan's hand.

Act III—The Valkyries fearing Wotan's wrath refuse to aid Sieglinde, but Brunnhilde disobeying his command gives her the fragments of Siegmund's sword and sends her into the forest where Fafner guards the ring. There she can safely await the birth of her expected child, Siegfried. Outraged, Wotan divests Brunnhilde of her divinity and orders her to the mountain, where she must sleep surrounded by the magic circle of fire until awakened by a hero.



### The Elixir of Love

Act I-Adina, a capricious country maid pretends to scorn the advances of the enamored Nemorino, a handsome young peasant, and reads to a companion the story of "Tristan and Isolde" and the magic love potion. As Nemorino gazes at her adoringly, Sergeant Belcore enters to plead his suit, and is also met with indifference. When Belcore leaves Nemorino again professes his love, but Adina spurns him and advises that he visit his dying uncle lest he lose his inheritance. At this point amid much confusion Dr. Dulcamara arrives vending his wonderful medicines, and Nemorino happily surrenders his last coin for an elixir to command love, actually a bottle of heady wine. He drinks the potion, confident it will make his love irresistable on the morrow, and fired by it he bursts into mirthful song, much to Adina's astonishment. Now confident of his potential power, Nemorino ignores Adina much to her pique and when Belcore enters to renew his suit she accepts and sets the wedding for six days hence. However, arriving soldiers announce that a move to new quarters has been ordered and Belcore persuades Adina to marry him that day. Overwrought, Nemorino pleads for a delay until tomorrow when the love potion will have taken effect. Adina laughs at him and invites the peasants to a wedding banquet and ball.

Act II—At the wedding feast the distracted Nemorino again meets the Doctor who recommends another bottle of the Elixir to quicken the action, but Nemorino does not have the necessary money. Belcore lamenting Adina's decision to postpone the wedding until evening, discovers the downcast Nemorino and persuades him to enlist in his company at which time he will be paid twenty-crowns.

Acr III—At this point the village girls, learning that Nemorino's uncle has died leaving him sole heir, shower him with attention. Unaware of the real cause, he attributes it to the elixir and when Dulcamara and Adina arrive he enthusiastically thanks the Doctor much to Adina's surprise. The Doctor then tells of the Elixir and moved by Nemorino's devotion Adina confesses her love to him, and informs him that she has rebought his enlistment contract. Belcore arrives to find the two embracing, so philosophically he marches away to other women and conquests. Nemorino is then informed of his inheritance, for which Dulcamara takes all credit, claiming this good fortune has been caused by the wonderful Elixir of Love.



### Simon Boccanegra

Note—In fourteenth-century Genoa both patricians and plebians are in constant strife, and the commoner, Simon Boccanegra having achieved far-reaching fame is on the brink of political triumph. However, he is denied recognition by the patrician, Fiesco, whose daughter, Maria, loves Simon and has borne him a child.

Acr I—Plebian leaders, Paolo and Pietro plan to raise Simon to the Doge's throne in return for certain favors. Simon agrees knowing that Fiesco will then be unable to prevent his marriage to Maria. The two meet and Fiesco demands custody of the child as the price of friendship. Simon cannot comply as the girl has disappeared, and the two men part enemies. Boccanegra entering the palace finds Maria dead.

ACT II, SCENE 1—Twenty-five years have elapsed. Fiesco, after Simon's rise to power has obtained anonymity by assuming the name of Andrea. Living in his care under the name of Amelia Grimaldi, her real identity unknown, is Simon's lost daughter. Plotting to overthrow Simon, Fiesco is aided by Gabriele Adorno, whom Amelia loves. Paolo also desires her, and Simon while at her castle to plead his courtier's cause discovers her true identity. He reveals himself as her father and learning that she loves Adorno refuses to look favorably upon Paolo, who then has her abducted.

Scene 2—Adorno, accused of killing Lorenzini, in whose home the abducted Amelia was found, is brought before the Doge. Paolo fearful of discovery tries to leave but the doors are guarded. Certain that Simon has master-minded the plot, Adorno tries to kill him, but Amelia intervenes. The Doge suspecting Paolo's treachery demands that he join him in a curse upon the abductor—an order Paolo cannot refuse.

ACT III, SCENE 1—The revengeful Paolo pours poison into the Doge's cup, and to make death certain tries to persuade Fiesco to kill him. When he refuses, Paolo tells Adorno that Amelia is now Simon's mistress. Adorno jealously confronts her, but Amelia denies the accusation and at Simon's approach she hides Adorno and pleads for his life. Simon agrees and left alone drinks from the poisoned cup. Adorno reveals himself and is about to kill the Doge when Amelia returns and tells him that Simon is her father. The repentant Adorno then vows loyalty to Simon and promises to help end the political rebellion. Scene 2—The uprising is quelled, and Paolo, captured in the ranks, although condemned to death triumphantly confesses to Fiesco that he has poisoned the Doge. Fiesco is aghast, even more so, when the dying Simon reveals Amelia's true identity. At that point the young couple and their bridal attendants enter, and the dying Simon summons his final strength to give them his blessing, and to confer the Doge's crown upon Adorno.
